Though darkness covers the earth, the glory of the Lord is upon YOU... Kings and Nations will come to your light."

### Some of 2018 highlights and activities include:

Ministering in the dance and the word in Sequim at the Sisters Ministry Conference. God had a plan and it was for Sharol Rosendahl, a Chippewa woman, to embrace her native heritage. Sharol was gifted leather regalia, given a native name and received many good words spoken over her. It was an honored time for our new friend.

Participating in the annual Women's Conference at All Tribes in Yakama. Perhaps the men will have their time in 2019. Later in the year, we joined the church for their campmeeting to witness Rosie Selland, Yakama, gifted her traditional clothing and sent out to minister to the African Nation as the Lord's servant and a Yakama tribal member.

Traveling to the Colville Reservations three times. The first time was to attend Charlie Gua's funeral in Nespelem and to speak at Keller Church. The second time, to attend a conference held in Nespelem. The third time was for an outreach on the Colville for the youth and children bringing hope, encouragement, and combat self-hate, hopelessness and suicide. During that time, we ministered in the area and spoke at the Keller Church. We thank the Puyallup Tribe of Indians for their support.

Makah Days is an annual event for Firestarters. This year we took several youth with us and were honored to be welcomed into the Edmisten's family and to camp on the family's camp grounds. A 30' Humpback whale was gifted to the Makah Nation and we were included in the partaking of whale meat. 2018 was truly an over-the-top celebration for the Makah Nation.

We continue to minister to shut-ins, distribute goods to those in need, attend pow wows, support native events, and other native ministries with participation including Muckleshoot Pentecostal Church, the Gathering, Sacred Path, Tacoma Indian Baptist Church and a new one...Discovery Church Mission Sunday.

Presently, we are working with 2 other ministries to host a native spring conference in April.
