Also in July, we attended the 3<sup>rd</sup> anniversary of the Pentecostal Church on Muckleshoot Reservation, helped facilitate the Honor Circle focused on men and women's relationships, began meeting with a couple marrying in August, established prayer time for deliverance and inner healing for individuals, began weekly meetings with one of the prayer groups birthed from Firestarters to correct, rebuke, encourage, and teach and attended the wedding of a person saved and baptized at Firestarters Monday gathering.
