We stayed at the YWAM camp at Hopi, ministered at the evening service of the church, were blessed to make new friends and reconnect with old friends. From Hopi, we traveled to Apache Junction and from there ministered on the Pima Reservation. Thursday, was the first day of the Native Women's Conference "The Intentional Woman" held at the American Indian College in Phoenix. Pat presented two workshops on Domestic Violence & danced. Several ladies were ministered to. The conference was awesome with a very large attendance. More ladies signed up to be on the Native Prayer Network so now we have 17 states represented plus 2 countries.

Near the end of the month, we attended a dinner at the Duwamish Longhouse. It was our first time to see the beautiful facility...very nice!

Our Monday night prayer gatherings continue to be very powerful and well attended. We pray, minister, and equip as the Lord leads. Prayer continues to go forth for the Nations and for the 65+ ministries we cover in prayer. The monthly Honor Circle is growing too.

Memorial Day weekend was family time. We stayed at Ocean Shores, traveled to Taholah to fish and cook hot dogs on the beach. Surprisingly, God had divine appointments there. We had a wonderful time in spite of the rain on Sunday. Our family had a blast and so did we.

For an update on FireTalkers...they continue to grow and see many prayers being answered. God is blessing them with "fruit". FireWalkers handed out over 1,000 "Books of Hope" on Tulalip. Their faithfulness and prayers are making an impact in their community. Wapato Firestarters are taking back the high places with prayer. Firestarters is looking forward to doing an outreach in Toppenish in August. We'll keep you informed.
