For the **first time in event’s 37 years** tribal relationships were acknowledged. This was a very awesome, timely event. Puyallup Tribal member, Connie McCloud welcomed people onto the land, Hattie Kauffman; Nez Perce spoke, Claudia Kauffman, Nez Perce, former state senator attended along with many other dignitaries.

Firestarters Ministries hosted “Arise, Shine Native Men & Women’s Conference” Nov 6, 7, 8, 2015 which was a huge success. The event was to bring “an awakening” to the People and honor Native American month of November. Over 600 people attended the weekend event. Native elders from our state shared their journey with the Lord at workshops Saturday. Our workshop speakers included: Doug James, Lummi; Aaron Williams, Alabama Coushatta; Ed Davis, Chinook; Kenny Williams, Muckleshoot and Wanda Sampson, Yakama; Ann Masten, Quinault, Stella Morrison, Yakama; and Charlotte Williams, Muckleshoot. Our Saturday evening speaker Hattie Kauffman, Nez Perce, was unable to be present due to an injury. Lynda Prince, life time Grand Chief of the First Nations People of Canada, spoke Saturday. Sunday morning, Swinomish Tribal Chair and President of the National Congress of American Indians, Brian Cladoosby spoke. During the lunch hour, Brian answered questions concerning Indian affairs. Brian represents the Indian Nations across the United States; Lynda Prince represents the First Nations people of Canada. **OH LORD HOW YOU HAVE BLESSED US INDEED bringing spiritual authority and government authority together for such a time as this.** The Auburn Reporter covered the event Sunday morning and TBN filmed Sunday morning service.
